



# How to build a Paper Structure

**Jon Addison** will be hosting a workshop on Wednesday, February 24<sup>th</sup> from 6p till 9p. This is the night before the official start of the 2016 Symposium. The structure shown is HO and I will have a few available if you wish to work in this scale. Otherwise we will be building in S scale.

**Building paper buildings** . This workshop will teach you how to use pastel paper planking to construct a building with a board on board method. When you are finished, your friends will swear it is out of wood. You will learn how to paint your "wood" planking, then cutting and gluing. Then how to finish the structure siding and with weathering and finally including a tar paper roof. You will learn how to finish the wood . Also how to finish the details in the photo.

## Paints –

Acrylic - one color of the building you wish it to be plus black, brown, burnt sienna, white ( bottled acrylic paints will do. )

Oil based - Raw sienna & paynes grey

If you can find this: It is called *transparent iron orange oxide*

**Tools-** #11 razor knife with extra blades, metal ruler, small square, pencil, yellow and tacky glue, various paint brushes including if possible a bristle filbert #4 long bristle brush from ( Michaels ) , closed handle tweezers, cutting pad

**Supplies** - you will need odorless Mineral spirits, dark brown weathering powder.

- The class will be limited to the first 15 people who register for this workshop.
- A list of tools needed to attend this workshop will be published.
- You will build a structure similar to this one in S scale ( see below ).
- Learn how to color cut and use pastel paper siding as wood planking.
- You will take and keep the structure you have created with you.
