



Sundance Central (1:20.3)

The Sundance Central Railroad is an Fn3 (1:20.3 scale) modular layout. The modular consists of 400 feet of hand laid code 250 aluminum rails that are hand spiked with individual tie plates onto wood ties with a total of 16 turnouts. The modular was built by a group of seven model train enthusiasts. This diverse group is made up of people who have a passion of early narrow gauge steam locomotives to modern day standard gauge diesels.

The purpose for forming this modular group was to provide the public a realistic look at model railroading in a large-scale format. The modules are highly detailed from the scratch built supporting structures and building down to surrounding scenery. The trains and rolling stock that will be running on these modules will also be highly detailed and weathered.
